Minutes of virtual meeting of the second part of "National Workshop on Development of Syllabus for Innovative Practices and Standards of Physiotherapy", held on 04.12.2020 at 10:00 am, organized by School of Physiotherapy, Delhi Pharmaceutical Sciences and Research University with the main agenda "Development of course structure & guidelines for Physiotherapy course in the light of NEP-2020 (National Education Policy) and global development" with the participation of various Councils of Physiotherapy in India.

Approximately, 100 numbers of participants had joined in the meeting through Google Meet and You Tube also. Dr. Nipul Salvi, President, Gujarat State Council for Physiotherapy, could not attend the meeting as he was not feeling well but conveyed his best wishes and message through his representative Dr. Zarna Shah, Vice President, Gujarat state council for Physiotherapy, in meeting.

Prof. Ramesh K. Goyal, welcomed all the members present in the meeting and expressed his sincere thanks for their valuable time. He presented the minutes of the last meeting before every member and clearly spelt out the highlights related to the syllabus. He also appreciated the words

said by Dr. Sudeep H. Kale during the last meeting that India is the 2nd largest country to provide HR to foreign countries in Physiotherapy. Prof. Goyal gave a suggestion to prepare a documentary of Physiotherapy and its councils. He also considered the industry and NGO networking for making the councils vibrant.

Major objectives of the second day of workshop were:

1. To compare the current status of Physiotherapy education in India and its comparison with that of other countries:
2. To develop the course framework for the Physiotherapy education, considering New Education Policy- 2020 and recommend various courses under following heads.
 - a) Foundation courses
 - b) Core courses
 - c) Allied courses
 - d) Skilled/ Specialized courses

Recommendation/ Discussion by the Members:

1. Dr. Arun K. Aggrawal in his opening remarks narrated "Let the Light of Physiotherapy spread the brightness in the welfare of the patients in society". He also said that the efforts should be made not only for creation of more jobs for physiotherapists but also making them more respectable with respect to pay scales and grades. He emphasized on the need to introduce of best practices such that it provides global opportunities. He also said that "Teaching hospitals are like raw petroleum product industry". Valuable ideas can come through diversified field of Physiotherapy. He also suggested to have integration with PHC/ CHC

Recommendation:

PHC and CHC must be collaborated.

2. Dr. V. P. Gupta emphasized on the need of robust syllabus prescribed and implemented by different councils. He mentioned that by and large similar exercise was done in past and syllabus was recommended but since almost over 15 years have passed, this is a very welcoming initiative. He supported for the same and assured to see that the revision of syllabus is to be made every 5 years.

Recommendation: Annual system should be there and Research Council must be formulated for carrying out research studies.

3. Dr. Zarna Shah, said that council should be independent, "e- Governance" – advisory should be forced. She emphasized on clinical posting hours should be more. Regular workshops must be conducted for the students.

Recommendation: Fewer hours should be adopted for Pathology and Microbiology. Research studies must be provided with grants by councils. Research Methodology must be taught in final year to have better insight of applied part.

4. Dr. Ravinder Mudgil, said that Yogic Sciences must be in foundation course. He also supported the Annual system for BPT course. Special techniques must be incorporated with the respective content of the subject. Dissection facility should be there in every Physiotherapy institute.

Recommendation: Official tie-ups with PHC and CHC should be there, especially during internship.

5. Dr. P.P. Mohanty, emphasized on semester system. Biophysics must be there in 1st year and biomechanics in 2nd year and all the Medical subjects must be taught in 3rd year and applied Physiotherapy subjects must be taught in 4th year.

Recommendation: There must be separate subject of Physiotherapy in Pediatric Conditions and Physiotherapy in Geriatric Conditions. Internship must be of a Year.

6. Dr. Maneesh Arora, emphasized on Annual System. Dissection should be there in virtual system. Practice skill must be included.

Recommendation: Patient handling skills, practical skills, insurance, business and organization administration and exercise prescription. CBCS must be adopted and an exit exam must be there.

7. Dr. Seema Grover suggested that flexibility should be given for studying management and law. CBCS must be there.

Recommendation: Clinical postings must be regular and rotational.

8. Dr. Shagun Aggarwal, insisted a on good pay scale for physiotherapy teachers and appropriate vacancies must be defined to have quality teaching.

Recommendation: Appropriate vacancies must be defined to have quality teaching.

9. Dr. Roshan Lal Meena, emphasized on Annual system. He suggested for changes in nomenclature of the subjects like Community Based Rehabilitation must be substituted by Rehabilitation, Organization and Administration and Orthopedics must be replaced by General Orthopedics. Communication skills and Computer must be optional. Advanced taping must be incorporated with Sports Physiotherapy.

Recommendation: Emergency care training should be there. Biophysics and Bioengineering should be incorporated in Electrophysiology. Internship may be of 11 months instead of 6 months. Case report should be there as a part of general assessment from 2nd Year onwards.

10. Dr. Sohrab Ahmad Khan also emphasized on the implementation of annual system. Yoga to be included as foundation course in 2nd year. Certificate course must be introduced.

Recommendation: General Surgery may be taught less and Obstetrics and Gynecology may be taught more.

11. Dr. Nidhi Kalra also suggested that Annual system is better than semester system. Yogic Sciences can be a part of Exercise Therapy. Biomechanics can be combined with Electrotherapy as students already learn many modalities in class XII. Communication Skills must be taught in combination with some other subject. Dry needling doesn't have any scientific basis. Internship must include rural exposure.

Recommendation: Advanced Taping can be a part of Ortho and Physiotherapy in Sports. Radiology and Radiodiagnosis can be combined with respective topics of orthopedics, neurology, cardiology and general surgery.

12. Prof. Amandeep suggested for Semester System with open elective subjects for the students. Internship must be on rotatory basis.

Recommendation: New techniques must be introduced into the course.

13. Dr. Jayprakash Jayvelu suggested for semester system. Log books must be maintained by the students during their clinical postings. Clinical Teaching and Clinical postings must be on the basis of well defined rotatory exposure.

Recommendation: Examination patterns must be integrated with theory and clinical assessment.

14. Dr. Nishat Quddus, suggested for the annual system and also said that Environmental Studies and Computer Applications and General foundation must be qualifying exam which is more of skilled course.

Recommendation: Subjects like Organization, Law and Ethics must be in Final Year.

After hearing views and suggestions of the well-versed speakers, Prof. Goyal concluded the meeting with the remark assuring them to come up with the blended ideas in next meeting. He also invited all for the participation in the third Meeting for which date will be decided.

Ms. Shilpa Jain coordinator of the workshop gave vote of thanks to all the speakers, members who devoted their precious time for the workshop. She also thanked Worthy Vice- Chancellor, DPSRU and the team of Physiotherapy for all their support and motivation.
