A Diploma in Pharmacy (D.Pharm) is a two-year undergraduate diploma program that focuses on the study of pharmacy practices, pharmaceutical sciences, and clinical pharmacy.

#### **Course Objectives**

- 1. **Pharmaceutical knowledge**: Understand the principles of pharmaceutical sciences, including pharmacology, toxicology, and pharmaceutical chemistry.
- 2. **Clinical pharmacy**: Develop skills in patient assessment, medication management, and pharmaceutical care.3. Pharmacy practice: Learn about pharmacy operations, dispensing, and patient counseling.

## **Eligibility**

Minimum qualification for admission in Diploma in Pharmacy- One who Passed 10+2 examination (science stream) with Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Mathematics. It is mandatory to clear Entrance Exam **JEECUP** 2025.

#### **Duration of Course**

The duration of the course shall be for two academic years with each academic year spread over a period of not less than one hundred and eighty working days in addition to 500 hours practical training spread over a period of not less than 3 months.
