

◆ Bachelor of Arts & Bachelor of Laws (BA.LL.B.)

BALLB (Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Laws) is a 5-year integrated undergraduate law program that combines the study of law with arts subjects.

Course Structure

- 5-year program
- Combination of arts subjects (e.g., English, History, Economics, Political Science) and law subjects (e.g., Constitutional Law, Contract Law, Tort Law)
- Students study arts subjects in the first two years and law subjects in the last three years.

Eligibility- 10+2 or equivalent qualification from a recognized board- Minimum (**Gen-45%, OBC-42%, SC/ST-40%** marks required)- Entrance exams like CLAT, LSAT, or AILET may be required.

◆ Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.)

LLB (Bachelor of Laws) is a 3-year undergraduate law program that focuses on the study of law and its applications.

Eligibility- Graduation or equivalent qualification from a recognized University Minimum (**Gen-45%, OBC-42%, SC/ST - 40%** marks required).

◆ Master of Laws (LLM)

LLM (Master of Laws) is a postgraduate law degree that provides advanced training in specialized areas of law. Here are some key aspects of the LLM program:

Course Structure- 2 year program

Divided into 4 semesters

Focuses on specialized areas of law, such as:

- Corporate Law
- Criminal law
- Constitutional Law
- Human Rights Law

• **Eligibility**- LLB or equivalent law degree from a recognized university- Minimum marks required
